Course Description

This 2 day course will focus on use of static and dynamic taping techniques to facilitate improved alignment and muscle re-education for function. Developmental biomechanics in relation to treatment will be reviewed. Tapes and interventions used include: Leukotape, Kinesio Tape [®], velcro patches with elastic straps, Fabrifoam wraps, Thera Togs™, SPIOs and DMO compression orthotics.

Program Objectives

UPON COMPLETION OF THE COURSE, PARTICIPANTS WILL BE ABLE TO:

- Identify specific developmental features in trunk, upper and lower extremities in relation to assessments for taping and strapping.
- Describe the importance of alignment for support and initiation of movement.
- Identify precautions and contraindications to taping.
- Describe the following taping materials: Leukotape, Hypafix/Coveroll, Kinesio [®] Tex tape, Velcro patches with velstretch, Fabrifoam wraps, Thera Togs™ and other compression orthoitics.
- Explain the use of taping to improve neuromuscular reeducation through alignment in functional activities.
- Describe skin care and tape removal for the pediatric population.
- Demonstrate a minimum of 4 taping techniques to address specific alignment concerns.

Participant Requirements

This entry-level course is open to physical therapists, occupational therapists and assistants, as well as athletic trainers, massage therapists and chiropractors. Participants should bring lab clothes (short, tank tops or bathing suits) in order to practice taping techniques, as well as a muscle atlas and scissors.

Patricia (Trish) Martin, PT, Certified Kinesio Taping ® Instructor, is the Director of Therapy Services at Cleveland Clinic Children's Hospital for Rehabilitation. She specializes in lower extremity biomechanics, casting, splint fabrication, and taping in the treatment of children with orthopedic and neurological involvement.
